




FEBRUARY MONTHLY REPORT ON ANTISEMITISM

In February, there was a decline in antisemitism levels across the analyzed platforms, with over 7 million pieces of content reviewed.

The return of the Bibas family's bodies sparked widespread solidarity among users in response to Hamas's atrocities. Meanwhile, there was a notable increase, particularly in Chile and Argentina, in content related to the Andinia Plan, a theory that claims that Jews seek to create a new state in Patagonia. The Iranian media outlet HispanTV published a report promoting this theory.

X (TWITTER)



On X (Twitter), antisemitic content accounted for 13.70%, lower than the last three months of 2024 (20.78%). Once again, this marks the lowest recorded level of antisemitism on X, coinciding with the ceasefire and the exchange of hostages and prisoners.


FACEBOOK



On Facebook, monthly antisemitism stood at 12.98%, in line with the last quarter of 2024 (11.83%).

- On YouTube, the level of antisemitism for the month was 5%, consistent with the last quarter of 2024 (5.83%).
- On Google, antisemitism stood at 3.33%, lower than the last three months of 2024 (4.44%).

DIGITAL MEDIA



In digital media comments, antisemitism was recorded at 12.98%, lower than the last quarter of 2024 (20.16%).

In preparing this report, information was gathered considering the language and its relevance.

Regarding language, all materials are in **Spanish**, except for the analysis of comments on digital media in Brazil. As for relevance, we used keywords related to Judaism and Israel, sourced from Google Trends. These keywords were selected based on high search volume and the absence of adjectival modifiers.

For X, Facebook, and YouTube comments, content was collected using a social listening platform that compiles data in real time. The categories analyzed in this report were shaped using sentiment analysis algorithms, Artificial Intelligence, and semantic analysis. This technological approach is further complemented by the interpretation and expertise of our analysts.
